Our staff is available to consult on any concerns you may have regarding selecting reading materials, accessing the Internet, and/or learning about the Library in general.

Today, your child was only allowed to borrow two (2) items. However, as soon as you sign the Parental Authorization Card below, your child will have full borrowing privileges. Please return the Parental Authorization Form to your branch library during your next visit and the library card will be issued. We hope that this policy will help you in monitoring your child’s reading activities.
