

Wi-Fi Internet Access Connection Procedure

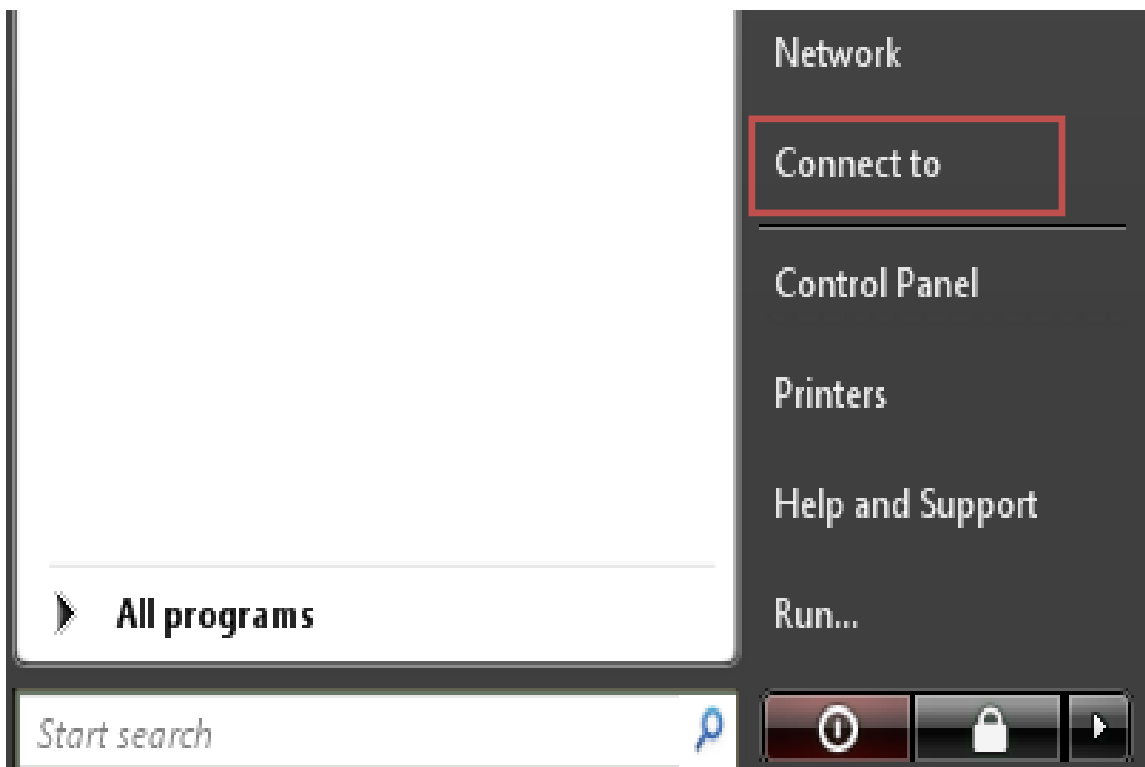
WINDOWS Vista

The library has provided wireless network service to connect your personal laptop to the World Wide Web while at your public library. All you need is a laptop, wireless adapter (Wi-Fi) and web browser. (NOTE: Your web browser must have cookies enabled to access the internet.)

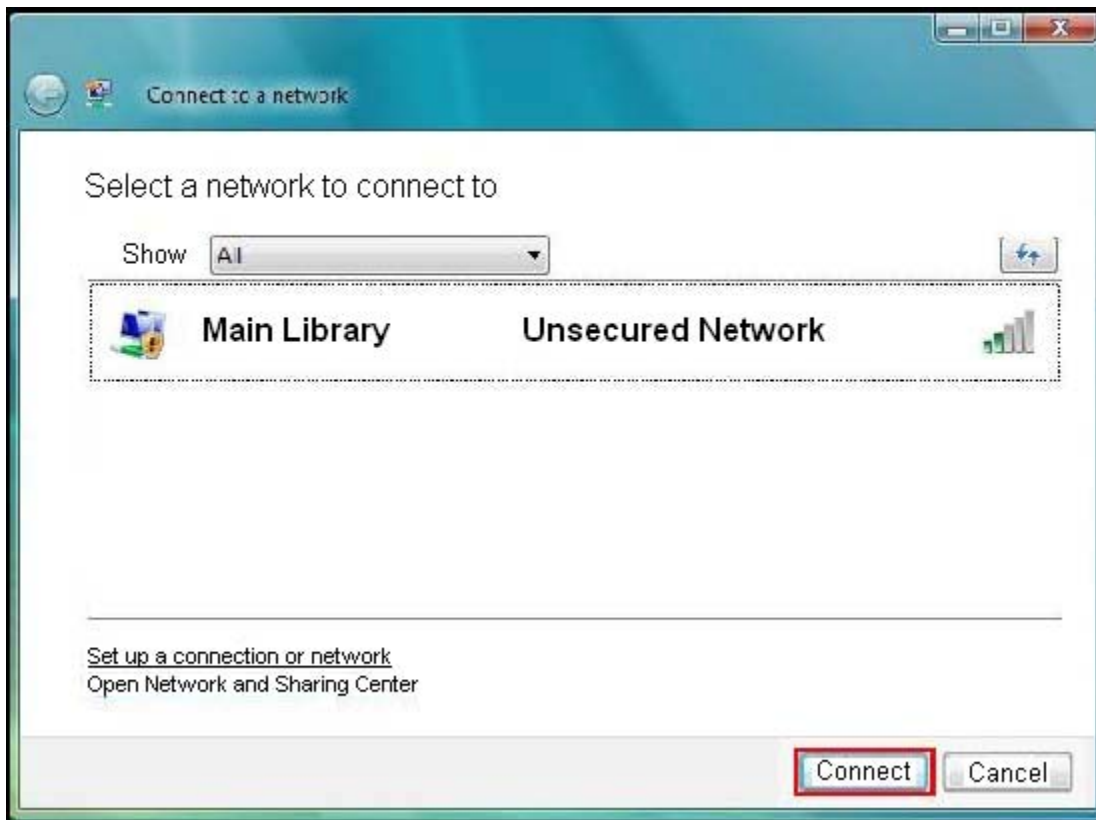
The following section describes in detail how to connect to a wireless network using the **Connect to a network** dialog box in Windows Vista. This document presumes that you have the appropriate permissions on your laptop to setup a wireless connection. NOTE: Windows Vista has additional security features that may periodically ask you if you want to continue making changes during the wireless setup process.



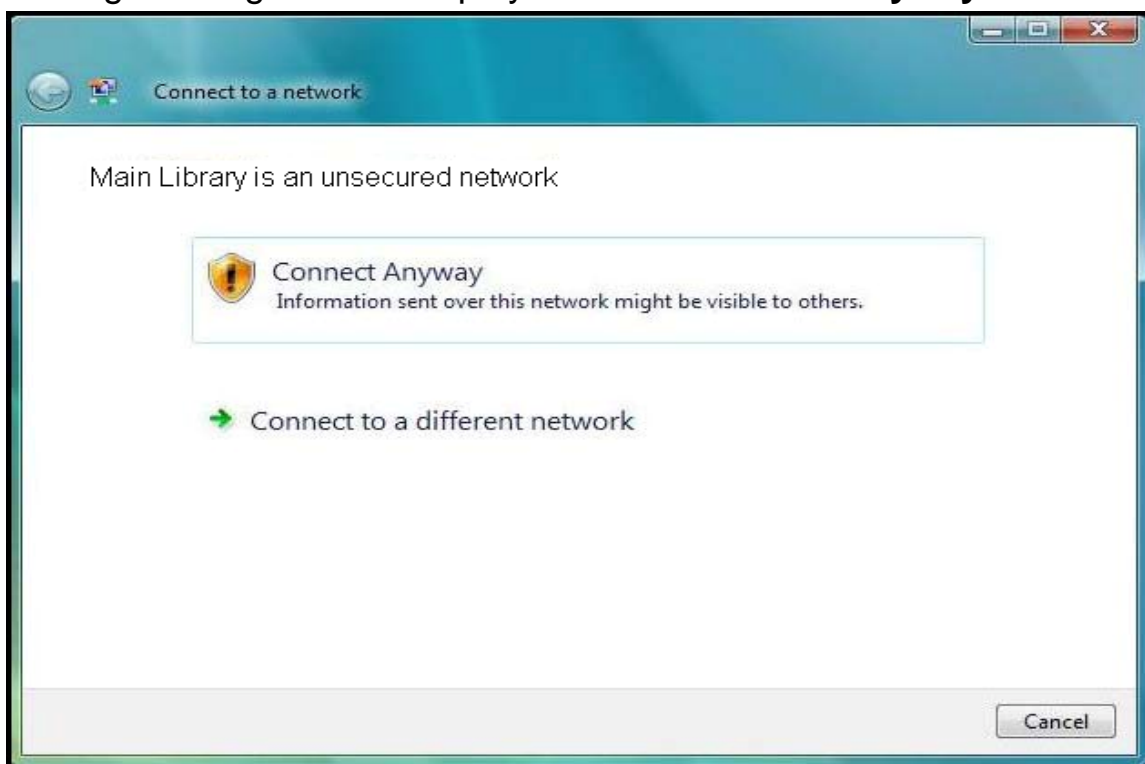
1. Click on the Windows button in the bottom left corner of the desktop.
2. Click on "**Connect To**".



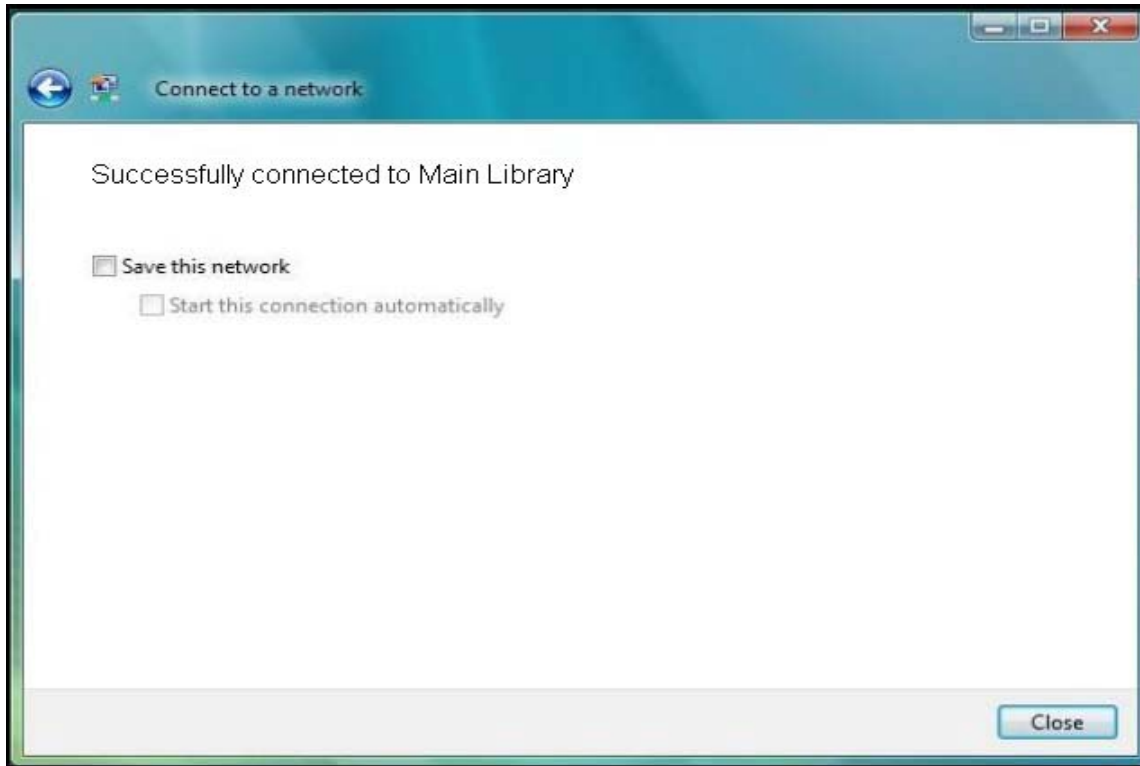
3. Under “*Select a network to connect to*”; The **Library’s Name** should appear, as shown below. Click the Library’s Name (ex.”*Main Library*”) to highlight and then click **Connect**.



4. A warning message will be displayed. Click **Connect Anyway**.



5. Once the connection has been established, the following dialog box will be shown. Click **Close**.



6. Now that your connection has been established, open your internet browser.
7. You will be directed to the page shown below:
